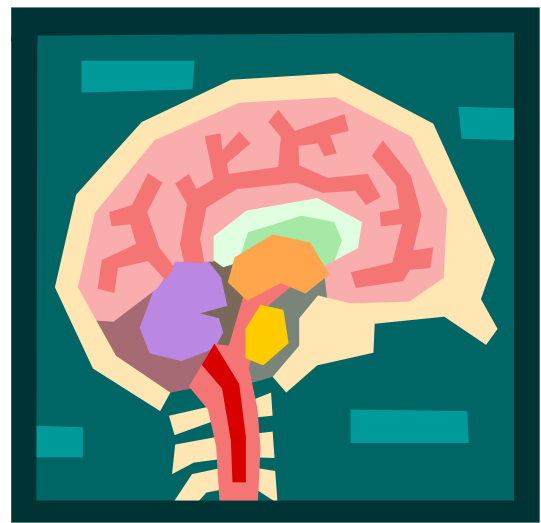

TARGET AUDIENCE

The target audience is nurses, occupational therapists, speech therapists, physical therapists, pharmacists, psychologists, mental health professionals, health educators, and other interested healthcare professionals.

REGISTRATION

Registration: Early registration deadline is **April 20, 2007**. Early registration fee is **\$50.00**. If registration is received after **April 20, 2007**, the fee will be **\$60.00**. **Participants who cancel prior to the early registration deadline will receive a refund for the amount they have paid less 30%. There will be no registration fees returned on cancellations that are made after the registration deadline.** Substitutions are generally accepted. Unforeseen circumstances may necessitate speaker substitution or program cancellation. If Area L AHEC cancels the program, all registrants will be notified, and refunds will be given as appropriate.

CREDIT

DIRECTIONS

From Raleigh, travel east on Highway 64. Upon reaching Rocky Mount, you will cross I-95. 3.3 miles after crossing I-95, exit to the right at the By-Pass South 301/Wesleyan Boulevard. Follow By-Pass 301/Wesleyan Boulevard 4.1 miles. Area L AHEC is on the left side of the road, immediately past the Highway 97/airport exit.

From Wilson, take Highway 301 North to Rocky Mount. Area L AHEC is on the right side of the road, 13.4 miles from the junction of Highway 301 and Highway 42 in Wilson, and approximately 3 to 4 miles past the only traffic light in Sharpsburg.
