PURPOSE: The purpose of this program is to discuss the philosophy and practice of the strength based approach, focusing particularly on the assessment and planning process. Assessment and treatment planning are the cornerstones for successful outcomes. Historically, we have been trained to identify and document deficits and pathologies. Problem focused assessment and interventions further reinforce what is “wrong” or “dysfunctional” with individuals and families. The strength based model has introduced a new way of working with people that represents a significant paradigm shift in how we are used to doing business.

TARGET AUDIENCE: This workshop would be beneficial for all human service practitioners (case/care managers, nurses, social workers, psychologists, counselors, etc.) and supervisors.
