About the Health Careers Awareness Course

Program Design:

This program is designed specifically for high school students interested in pursuing a career in health and/or science, and educators who provide career counseling or support services to students.

Preliminary workforce data in the Area L AHEC region indicates a significant workforce shortage in healthcare professions. Area L AHEC desires to promote student interest in health careers.

Target Audience:

The program is targeted to students who have an interest in health careers, and the teachers and counselors who are in a position to assist students in making career choices.

Credit:

The program is planned as a four-day intensive course, and 2.0 units (20.0 contact hours) of teacher renewal credit will be granted to individuals completing all four days.

Objectives:

1. Discuss various career options in health and health care
2. Identify and describe the job responsibilities, training, and educational requirements in specific health professions.
